





Policies against depopulation in mountain areas


- The practice is located in 8 municipalities in the Mountain region
- Røros and Tynset are regional centers with 2500 inhabitants each
- The whole region has a population of 23 000
- Aim is to become 25 000 in 2020
 - A region with stable work marked, good services, schools, kinder gardens
 - 5 h drive to Oslo, 3 h drive to Trondheim
 - Stable climate
 - Fabulous mountain riding terrain
 - Large grazing areas, vibrant agriculture

What was the problem?










Migration to central areas has been a trend for 20 years. Today 56% of the population lives in lagre city areas

Negative birthrate is equaled by migration




What did we do?



- Make the Montain Region of Norway the ultimate horse destination for experienses and settlement
 - Arrange a yearly land leading horse festival
 - Develop a regional website
 - Facilitate traveling by horse
 - Enchase horse related occupations
 - Facilitate equestrian living areas, riding arenas/halls
 - Facilitate Storsteigen Agricultural College as a center for horse related courses and education
 - Attract/keep women in the region



How long?







- Started as a private initiative with the formation of the organization Hesteriket
 - Project idea
 - **Project description**
- Supported by Hedmark County Council, Hedmark County and municipalities
- Project owner; Mountain Region of Norway
- Cooperating with the Interreg project Scandinavian Heartland





















How did we do?



- Hestival with Star-ride has become a yearly event
 - Has attracted 2000 visitors and 200 riders
 - Promotes the region
- Riding and driving paths have been mapped
 - With places to stay for horse and rider
 - Up and coming Bed and Box website
- Website Hesteriket.no is welcoming horse-people, spreading news
- 6 different high quality riding-products has been developed for the international marked (Interreg)
- Study trip and seminar with local offices and land owners concerning equestrian living areas and riding hall (Interreg)
 - Initiated a committee that is working with financing a regional riding hall and solutions for equestrian living areas
- Storsteigen as center for courses and education
 - Has hosted the Hestival 3 times
 - We have, through Interreg contact with top competence on horse tourism development
 - Could lead to a national/international education/course on horse tourism?
- Survey about horse as lifestyle and occupation in the Mountain Region







Does it work?



- Mapping of newcomers has revealed
 - 60 horse settlers the last 6 years
 - 8 new horse businesses
 - 15 (8+7) new employees connected to the sector
- Results of our survey indicates that
 - Our efforts attract/hold women in the region
 - Our region houses many horses
 - There is a big demand for a regional riding hall













Finances

- To little finances/resources to bee able to work well on all areas
- Wasted time on financing the project (results before financing)
- The Interreg project Scandinavian Heartland has made us able to fulfill activities on all areas

Little faith

- Among the public: Why favor the horse sector, is this region only for those with special interests?
- Among the horse people: We are not that outstanding

Many partners involved

- Different opinions among the horse people
- Few opinions from the financial partners

Cooperation with Hesteriket organization

- Lots of ideas unclear borders, who leads the project?
- Easy access to the target group through the organization
- Lots of voluntaring





- To facilitate a region as a horse region is new in Norway
 - Exists in Sweden; Heby, Falkenberg and Gagnef
 - Study trip to Falkenberg led to the formation of Hesteriket
- Hestival with Star-Ride is a new concept in Norway
 - There are horse shows but not where you can bring your own horse, Norwegian ide exported to Sweden
- Bed and Box site is new in Norway
 - We got the idea on a study trip to Sweden
- International horse riding holidays is new in Norway
 - Until now only riding holidays for the national marked

- National strategies
 - 11 different strategies to keep population in rural areas
 - One strategy is providing small farms for sale and hire (Buskerud county)
- Regional Move Here Campaign 2001-2011
 - Promotion campaign for the Mountain Region
 - Promotion cooperation stranded as the demand for small horse farms was greater than the access
 - Cooperated on seminar about Equestrian living and a movie profiling settlers
- We are hoping efforts toward the horse sector will bee accepted as a strategy to enchase settlement and economic growth in rural areas
- That a regional riding hall and equestrian living areas will bee supported locally and nationally

- Great transferability to other areas
 - Many people have interests that fits well with a rural lifestyle hunting, horse-riding, sled-dogging, farming..
 - Rural regions has advantages compared to cities regarding lifestyle living
- This trend attracts migrants from urban areas
 - Often well situated
 - Does not have rural roots
 - Move to the most suitable place
 - Preferably where there are attractions/facilities/others with the same interest
- Facilities and suitable homes are necessary to get full effect
