

KEY FEATURES

Minimum budget ringfencing of **total EAFRD** contribution:

- 30% for interventions addressing the three environmental/ climate objectives
- **5**% for LEADER

Mandatory risk management tools and Risk Management Strategy

Easier to plan locally led schemes and result based schemes

Higher support rates for investment

Digitisation strategy to be included in the CAP plan

Possibility of using financial instruments (incl. working capital), also in combination with grants
